## PE and Sports Premium: 2016 - 2017

We continue to be fully committed to getting the best provision possible for our pupils. This additional funding from the government to all state primary schools allows us to achieve this. Our school's Governing Board receives information from the Head teacher on how this funding is spent; governors then monitor the impact.

Sports Premium funding is ring-fenced and therefore can only be used on the provision of PE and Sports in schools. Schools are required to report on the amount of funding received and how the funding is being used.

Contribution to after school sports clubs and PPA cover - specialist sports coaching (Sporting World)	£5916
Termly swimming sessions at KA: key focus on skills with 100% pupils being able to swim by KS2.	£1000

*AUTUMN/SPRING 2016-17	£4903 - provisional

Impact - questions to consider to monitor on-going impact.

- ✓ What events have our pupils attended?

- ✓ How well have they performed - placing and behaviour/attitude/effort?
- ✓ How many are attending our netball club? What is the feedback from Miss Steninger our sports leader?
- ✓ What is the feedback from Sporting World Coach? How many pupils have increased their skill level?
- ✓ Feedback from Miss Steninger on weekly swim sessions - who have moved in to the next group? Feedback from pupils - has water confidence increased? Do they enjoy the session? Impact on out of school swimming?

At the end of Summer Term, 2017 - the above questions and answers will form the basis of the monitoring and evaluation / impact report.
